

QCTiP2025 is dedicated to providing a harassment-free conference experience for everyone, irrespective of gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, age, religion, or nationality. We take a zero-tolerance approach to harassment of conference participants in any form. Conference participants violating this code of conduct may be sanctioned or expelled from the conference at the discretion of the conference organizers. Our anti-harassment policy is as follows:

Harassment includes, but is not limited to:

- Verbal comments that reinforce social structures of domination
- Sexual images in public spaces
- Deliberate intimidation, stalking, or following
- Unwanted photography or recording
- Sustained disruption of talks or other events
- Inappropriate physical contact
- Unwelcome sexual attention
- Advocating for, or encouraging, any of the above behavior

Enforcement

Participants asked to stop any harassing behavior are expected to comply immediately.

If a participant engages in harassing behavior, event organizers retain the right to take any actions to keep the event a welcoming environment for all participants. This includes warning the offender or expulsion from the conference.

Event organizers may take action to redress anything designed to, or with the clear impact of, disrupting the event or making the environment hostile for any participants.

We expect participants to follow these rules at all event venues and event-related social activities.

Reporting

If someone makes you or anyone else feel unsafe or unwelcome, please report it to conference staff as soon as possible. Harassment and other code of conduct violations reduce the value of our event for everyone, and we want the event to feel and be a safe space.

You can make a report either personally or anonymously.

We can't follow up an anonymous report with you directly, but we will fully investigate it and take whatever action is necessary to prevent recurrence.

Personal Report

You can make a personal report by:

When taking a personal report, our staff will ensure you are safe and cannot be overheard. They may involve other event staff to ensure your report is managed properly. Once safe, we'll ask you to tell us about what happened – you are welcome to bring someone to support you. You won't be asked to confront anyone, and we won't tell anyone who you are.

Our team will be happy to help you contact local law enforcement, local support services, provide escorts, or otherwise assist you in feeling safe for the duration of the event.
